The Ossining Public Library is proud to announce that Carry Cubillos, the library's Cultural Programming Specialist, will be honored as a dedicated community member and person of distinction in Westchester by the Westchester County Board of Legislators. She will receive her award at the Board of Legislators' Hispanic Heritage Month Celebration on September 16th.

Ms. Cubillos, who has worked at the library since 1998, was integral in spearheading Spanish-language programming at the library.
