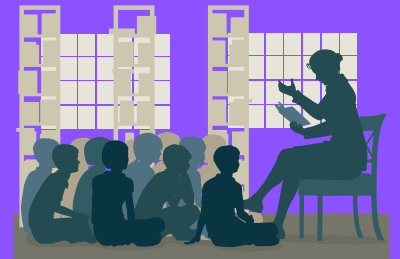


Trivia Tuesday

Picture This!



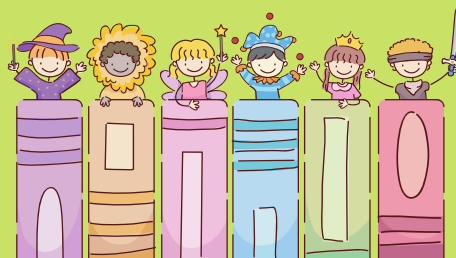

- 11) Grandpa tells a story about a land with delicious weather.

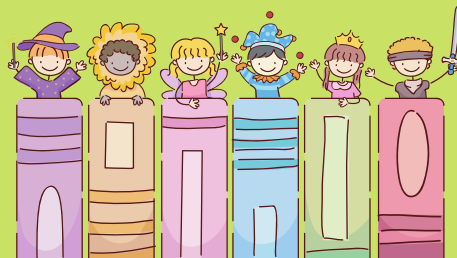
