Hidato Puzzles present you with a partly filled grid of numbers and challenge you to fill out the empty spots so that there is a path of numbers in counting order. This means 1 is next to 2, 2 is next to 3, and so on. On a square grid, numbers are next to each other vertically, horizontally, and diagonally.

In the puzzles listed here, the numbers for each grid will always start and end 1 and the highest will be the total number in the spaces in the grid. These simple puzzles to get you started will all be on square grids, but the puzzles can be on hexagon grids or boards of different designs.
