



OPLbery Club Rules

- Speak loudly enough to be heard.
- No private conversations.
- Speak briefly when it's your turn.
- Listen carefully to what other people say.
- There are no right or wrong answers.
- Use the Discussion Guidelines when talking about a book.
- Be specific about what you like or dislike about a book. (Example: don't say "It's good/nice/bad....")
- Only discuss books being considered for this year's OPLbery Award.
- Each club member should try to read at least 2 books before the next meeting and be prepared to discuss them.
- Do NOT give away the ending of the book!
- Write down the title and author of every OPLbery book you read on your OPLbery Club book list. Give each book a rating (1-5) and a brief explanation of why it is or isn't OPLbery-worthy.
