



Everything you need to know about Curbside Pickup at the Ossining Public Library

Starting June 1, patrons with Ossining Public Library cards will be able to place holds on items in the Ossining library collection, and pick them up at the Ossining library.

After you've been notified that your hold is available, you can come to the library during one of our pickup windows:

Monday, 10-2

Tuesday, 2-6

Wednesday, 4-8

Thursday, 4-8

Friday, 2-6

Saturday, 10-2

Or by appointment.

Once you arrive at the library, go to the lower level parking lot and text (914)918-0720 or visit our curbside communicator online at <https://widget.uniquelibrary.com/configs/opl.html>

You will be prompted for your name and library card number, and asked whether you drove or walked to the library.

Please wait in your car (or, if you walked to the library, by the stairs).

A staff member will drop your materials off at our pickup table, which will be under the **OPL** tent on the lower level.

Once the staff member has gone back inside, you can retrieve your materials. Happy reading!

Please know that we have implemented safety procedures to ensure that circulating materials are safe.

- Upon return, materials will be quarantined for 72 hours.
- Library staff will be wearing masks, and practicing CDC-recommended hand hygiene
