This year, the Foundation has re-committed to being a vigorous and proactive supporter of the library, through executing fundraisers, soliciting donations and bequests, and securing grants.

As part of their revitalized efforts, the Foundation has laid out a roadmap for 2021 and identified key projects to fund, which will have a tangible impact on the library's service and patrons.

JANUARY 2021: The Foundation launched a successful grassroots fundraiser for the extensive repairs needed for the library's Steinway grand piano by forging community partnerships and appealing to the library's loyal user base.

SPRING 2021: The Foundation has pledged to raise money to refurbish the library's Budarz Theater. The site of hundreds of concerts, events, and performances, the theater is in need of paint work. The Foundation has committed to raising \$15,000 to fund the painting, and to restore the Budarz Theater to its status as a refined and professional performance space.

FALL 2021: The Foundation plans to undertake a major project aimed at raising funds needed to purchase modular spaces that would provide more library meeting spaces for community use.
