Call to Order

Meghan Huppuch called the meeting to order at 6:05pm.

1. 2025/2026 Budget Proposal

2. Discussion of temporary library space for use during OPL building closure due to construction

Karen LaRocca-Fels provided the BOT with a verbal update on the status of the site visit – which included a few BOT members – and internal staff contingency planning discussions. BOT discussion focused on engaging a commercial realtor to take the lead in expanding the search for possible alternate locations and the BOT members reaching out to owners of possible alternate locations in the community that they are aware of to increase the search.

3. Building Project Meeting for Community Leaders BOT discussion acknowledged that now is the time to begin planning dates and moving forward with outreach.
